Jefferson Vineyards - Cabernet Franc

Vintage 2004. One of the most adaptable grapes to Virginia's humid summers, the '04 Cabernet Franc is a dark, sumptuous wine showing subtle but hefty palate weight. Aromas of red berries dominate the nose while the palate shows similar fruits and spice balanced by moderate acidity and soft tannins. This wine pairs nicely with chicken, pasta and light beef dishes.
