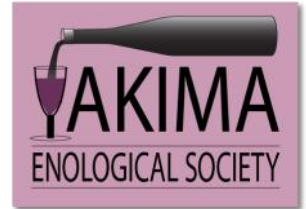

The Carousel Restaurant and Bistro is located in the historic Front Street district (25 North Front Street). We will begin the evening at 6:30 with registration. You will be greeted with **Francois Montand** Champagne. Afterwards you will be escorted to the event space inside the restaurant. The cost is \$35 for members/\$45 for non-members. If non-members decide to become members, their extra \$10 will go towards a membership.
