

The Blind Leading the Blind: Educate Your Nose!

Did you know that 70% of what you taste in wine comes from its aroma? Our sense of smell plays a key role in identifying the subtle flavors that make each wine unique. Developing this skill is possible with practice, and this event is designed to help you do just that.

Step 1: Train Your Nose

We will start with an aroma workshop, featuring wines infused with distinct scents like citrus, leather, and berries. Compare these aromas to your own flavor memories and see how many you can identify.

Step 2: The Blind Tasting Challenge

Test your nose and palate with a blind tasting of nine Pacific Northwest wines:

- Three White Wines
- Three Rosés
- Three Red Wines

Can you match the aromas and flavors with the tasting notes provided by the wineries?

What to Bring:

Please bring three wine glasses to help you compare each flight of wines side by side.

Don't miss this opportunity to sharpen your senses and discover new wines.

Our evening featured WIT Cellars wines made by Cat Locano and her partners. Cat was one of Yakima Valley College Winery Technology Graduates and was a Yakima Enological Society scholarship recipient, exemplifying what YES is all about.

The dinner was held at the Yakima Area Arboretum and 56 happy guests were treated to a 5-course medly of surf n' turf which included 4 different oysters prepared 3 different ways, super slaw salad with sauvignon blanc vinaigrette and cucumber sorbet, Dry riesling poached shrimp fettuccini with pesto cream sauce, Montreal Style tri-tip over parsnip puree topped with Syrah demi-glace and sweet crisp onion. We finished with sparkling rose strawberry sauce drizzled over angel food cake. All courses were expertly paired with 5 WIT Cellar Wines. A short presentaion on the Merroir of Oysters highlighted the evening and a good time was had by all.
